On a nature walk

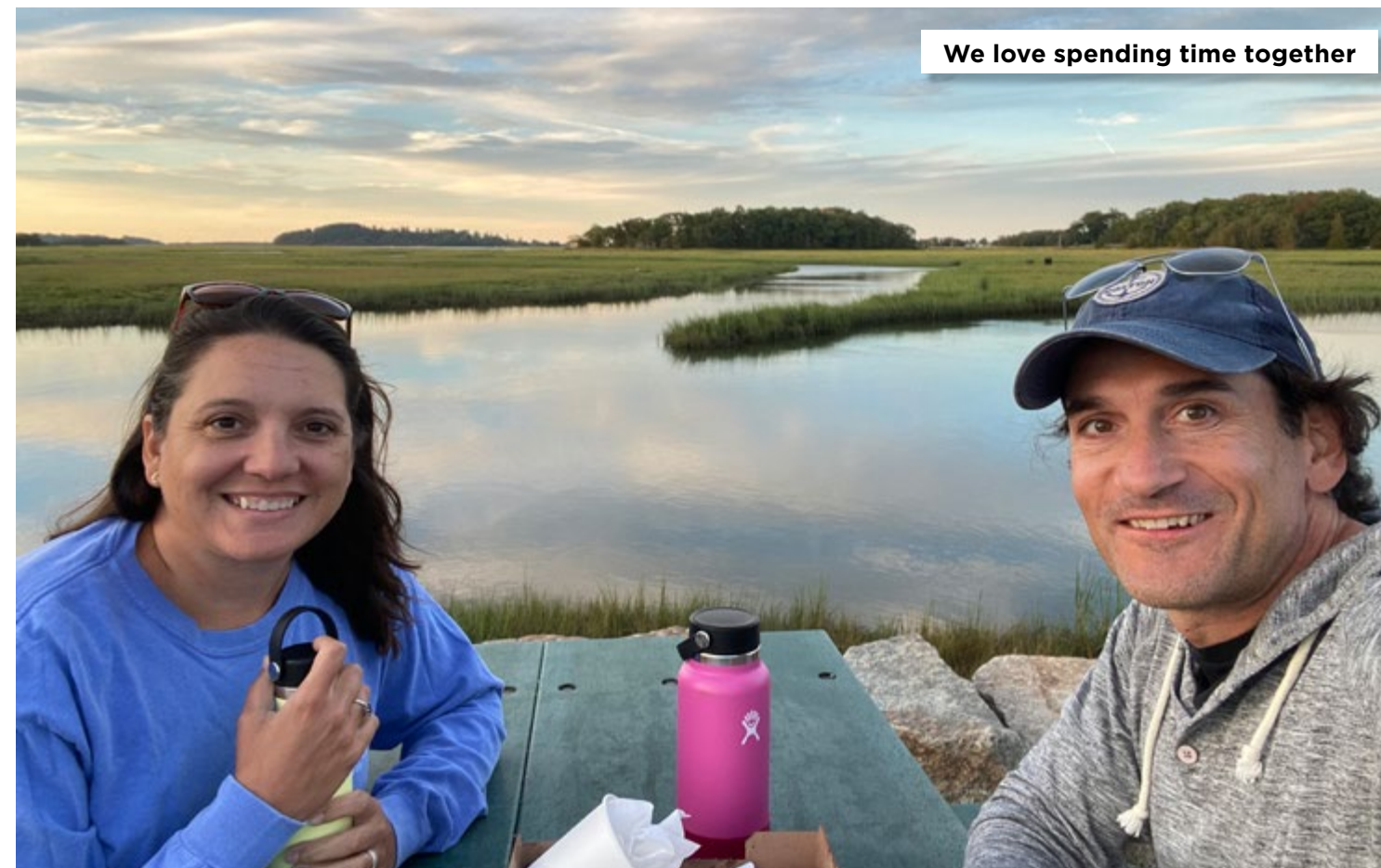

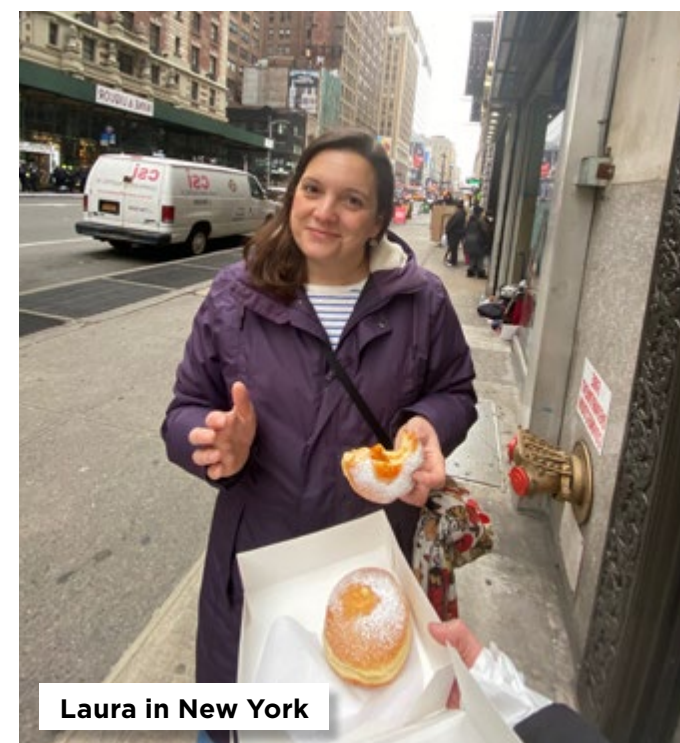
Laura in Quebec

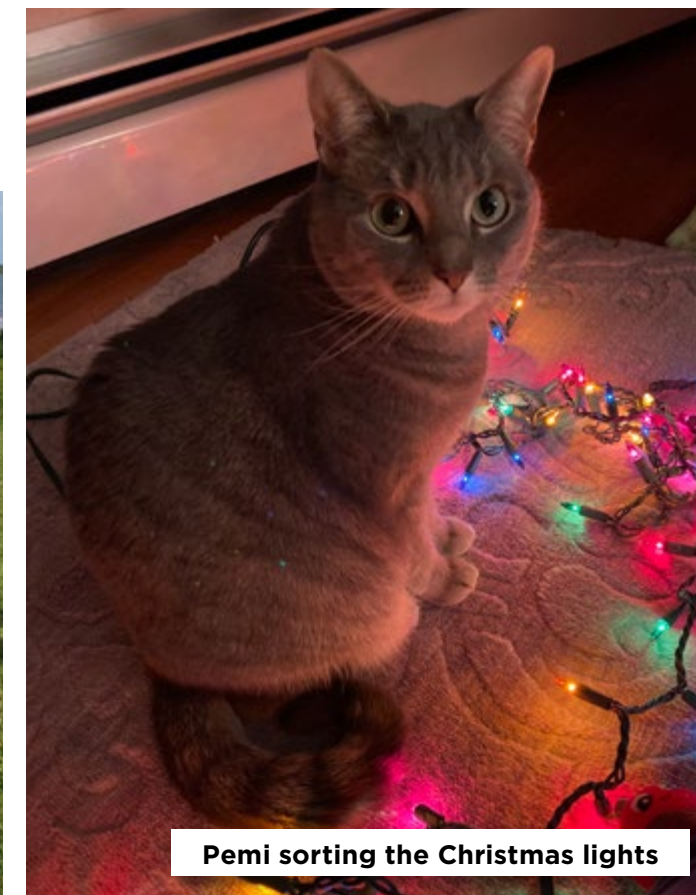
